



## AWARD OF CAP MEDALS, RIBBONS AND CERTIFICATES

CAPR 39-3, 22 Feb 10 is supplemented as follows:

10c(4). All nominations for distinctive Minnesota Wing awards will be forwarded by the applicable Wing Headquarters department director to the Awards Review Board with their recommendation for approval or disapproval not later than one week before the scheduled meeting of the Awards Review Board. Directors do not have authority to approve, disapprove or return nominations. Only the Awards Review Board can return an award to the nominator.

15d. The Grover Loening Aerospace Award will be presented by the Group Commander.

15e. The Paul E. Garber Award will be presented by the Wing Commander. Per CAPR 50-17

15f. The Gill Robb Wilson Award will be presented by USAF or CAP general officer, state or federal government elected official, or other distinguished person. Per CAPR 50-17.
