SUBJECT: POV use for CAP Activities

1. In accordance with CAP regulation 77-1 Para 1-8b, POVs may be used as transportation to and from CAP activities, and such transportation is solely at the risk of the individual CAP member and their passengers. This letter provides blanket authorization for such transportation to and from funded ES missions (training and actual), and may be used as documentation to be uploaded to WMIRS. This authorization does also permit such personal transportation to be reimbursed as a mission expense. Such transportation shall not be deemed unusual, but rather routine, nor shall it be deemed "official CAP transportation," and therefore no further case-by-case approval is required. This authorization does not extend to include authorization of POVs for use in ground sorties or other "official CAP transportation" uses. Such uses will require further case-by-case authorization as described in CAP regulation 77-1. Written approval for use of a POV will be maintained on file in accordance with CAPR 10-2, Files Maintenance and Records Disposition.

2. This plan is approved by the Minnesota Wing Commander.
