

2024 MN Wing Conference Code of Conduct for Cadets

Curfew:

Friday night in your room by 10:00 pm

Saturday night in your room by 12:30 am

Required Check Ins:

Sat AM: 0730-0745: In-person check in with your senior member in charge in the General Assembly space.

Sat PM: Check in with your senior member in charge after the military ball no later than 12:30 am confirming you are in your hotel room.

Expectations

- Wing conference is a professional development event; follow all CAP rules & regulations including on public displays of affection (hand holding, hugging)
- No behavior that reflects poorly on you, your unit or CAP. "Do not bring shame on your CAP family."
- Do not leave the property.
- Males and females are not allowed in each other's hotel rooms at any time.
- Wingman system, groups of 3 when not in the main conference meeting areas. i.e. to/from lodging, pool area.
- During the afternoon Saturday, cadets do not need to stay with a wingman as long as they are in the conference center, breakout session area.
- You are free to attend any breakout session you want and are expected to attend one workshop during each session.
- Stay in your hotel room between curfew (see above times) and 6:30 am the next day.
- Anytime you leave the hotel room, you must take a wingman. Groups of three (3) are preferred.
- You MUST check in with your senior point of contact Saturday morning before the General Assembly.
- Check in with your senior point of contact as listed above. The method of check-in is at the discretion of the squadron/senior member.
- For emergencies at any time, contact your senior member in charge.
- Call 911 first if it is a true medical emergency.
- Cadets driving themselves to the conference will be required to turn their keys in when they check in. The keys will be returned to your senior member in charge after the banquet.

UOD (Uniform of the Day) for Wing Conference:

- Friday Social: Appropriate civilian attire
- Saturday morning/afternoon: Blues (short-sleeve or class A's) or civilian equivalent
 - Civilian equivalent: dress shirt/slacks or conservative dress/skirt
 - ABU should not be worn at any time during Wing Conference
- Saturday Banquet & Military Ball: Class A Blues, short sleeved blues or civilian equivalent.
 - Jacket and tie or shirt and tie with dress pants.
 - Formal or semi-formal gown for females. Due to the professional nature of this event, no plunging necklines, bare midriffs, or open backs below bra line. Appropriate length is fingertips or longer.

Sample cadet packing list:

- Full Blues uniform (you will be wearing this all-day Saturday). We all need to look sharp. Bring your lint roller, shoe polish, hair comb, etc.
- Black socks, black uniform shoes and V-neck t-shirt are required.
- Banquet clothing (you can wear your blues, Class A's or short sleeves, civilian suit if you want. Females can wear an appropriate formal or semi-formal dress as indicated above)
- Sleeping clothes for 2 nights
- Swimwear (optional - there is a pool at the resort if you want to swim) – *Coverups should be worn between rooms and the pool area.*
- 2 sets of casual civilian clothes
- All toiletries for 2 nights
- Undergarments for 2 days
- Sleeping bag/pillow (optional - most hotel rooms will have 2 beds and 4 cadets)
- Money for food Friday night and Sunday morning, depending on your personal situation.
- Snacks (optional if you want snacks for your hotel room)
- All needed medication
- Phone/Chargers/etc
